PURPOSE

What is the Emeritus Mentoring Program?

The Emeritus Mentoring Program (EMP) was initiated in 2005. It's purpose is to provide guidance to undergraduate students and junior faculty. It provides UCSD Emeriti Association members with an opportunity to make a positive and personally meaningful contribution to the university by helping undergraduate students and junior faculty steer their educational and professional careers to greater success.

What does Mentoring Entail?

Because "mentoring" can mean many different things to different people, the details about what is done, and how often the mentor/mentee meet is left up to each mentor.

To become a mentor, a commitment for the entire academic year is required.

How are Mentors/Mentees Matched Up?

Like a good marriage, a successful mentoring relationship is highly dependent upon mutual interests and compatible personalities. Thus, the EMP allows mentees to select their own partner (mentor) based on professional and extra-curricular interests. Modification of a mentor/mentee partnership (dissolution), is allowed should the initial mentor/mentee relationship prove to be unsatisfactory to either partner.
