As we leave the airport, our conversation continues with my dad speaking in Lao, my mom in Chinese (Hakka), and me responding in both English and Hakka. This is how I grew up, where my Asian heritage and American values intermix to form my identity.

While I do not think about it often, I do recognize the significance of my cultural background, as it led to my desire to study abroad and learn more about the cultures of the world. I applied to the University of Sussex in England, for Spring semester of 2019. I chose this location and university after much deliberation, as I still wanted a university town atmosphere, but with the ease of traveling to other European countries. I also chose this location because I was interested in learning first hand, how the culture there differs from my American one despite their similarities in language. What better way to do this than to immerse oneself in said environment?
